

Public Inquiry into Application for Planning Permission - new school, Les Quennevais

Inspector's Preliminary Note

I am putting this note on the inquiry website for the information of all interested parties. At the time of writing (late October 2016) I do not know which bodies or individuals may wish to take part in the inquiry, whether participants intend to be represented by advocates, how many witnesses may give evidence, or what topics may be covered.

It would help me to have early information on the above matters. All interested parties are therefore asked to send details, including time estimates wherever feasible, by email to the Programme Officer Mrs Christine Self (ac.self@blueyonder.co.uk) as soon as possible.

I hope to prepare a provisional timetable for the inquiry after I receive statements of case (the closing date for which is subject to separate public notice). At that stage I also intend to issue guidance about the submission of proofs of evidence and other documents, but all those who may be involved are asked to note now that the submission of proofs is likely to be required at least 14 days before the start of the inquiry.

As an alternative to appearing at the inquiry, any interested person or organisation may submit written representations through the Programme Officer, preferably also by email.
