Reconsiderations and Appeals Process

in relation to:

Control of Housing and Work (Jersey) Law 2012

Re-considerations and appeals

If an applicant is aggrieved by a –

- (a) condition relating to a person's residential and employment status;
- (b) determination of a persons' residential and employment status;
- (c) determination in respect of the categorisation of a unit of dwelling accommodation or the conditions relating to such categorisation;
- (d) refusal to grant consent for occupation of a unit of dwelling accommodation;
- (e) refusal to grant consent to a purchase by a legal person or the imposition of a condition;
- (f) refusal of the grant of a licence;
- (g) imposition of a licence condition or the refusal to impose a requested licence condition;
- (h) variation or refusal to vary a condition of a licence;
- (i) revocation of a licence;
- (j) notice requiring cessation of activity;

the applicant has the following courses of action: -

Reconsideration

If the applicant wishes to challenge the decision, they can ask for a reconsideration by submitting any additional information that was not submitted as part of the original application or if the circumstances have changed, within four weeks of the original decision being made.

Should the applicant continue to be unsatisfied with the decision once the above process is complete, the following courses of action remain open.

Statutory Appeal

Under Article 41 of the Law, any person aggrieved by a decision may, within two months of the date of the decision, or within such longer period as the Court may allow, appeal to the Court on the grounds that the decision is unreasonable having regard to all the circumstances of the case.
