
As a company owner/manager/user you are responsible for ensuring ALL your staff are aware, understand and comply with:

- The ERF's Waste Acceptance Criteria and Site Rules
- Understand where the correct area to take waste is bulky, tipping hall or recycling

It is not the responsibility of the site staff to inform your employees of the information above, they are onsite to ensure everyone is safe, offer advice and ensuring the WAC is adhered to. As a company owner/manager you need to ensure all your staff using the site are aware, fully understand and comply.

Please give drivers copies of the WAC and site rules for their reference to have available in their vehicle. Any continual flouting of these rules will lead to access being denied and account closed.

The WAC and Site Rules may be changed from time to time. We will email updates to the email provided on your weighbridge application. It is your responsibility to inform us of any changes to your contact email.

Any deliveries skip volume or more will be turned away if not prebooked. |
| Healthcare Waste – white bags 'offensive waste' | Only in approved heavy duty 'Offensive Waste' bags | Must only be unloaded into an 'open door' No unauthorised healthcare waste will be accepted. Healthcare waste must be from licenced registered companies only. |

Weighbridge Access and Site Information Site Rules

- We use CCTV cameras to monitor and record customer activities. This data can be
 used where unacceptable behaviour or illegal activity is seen and this data can be
 used by the police. The Energy Recovery Facility of Infrastructure and Environment is
 registered with the Jersey Information Commissioner (Notification 15801). IHE ERF is
 the data controller for the CCTV system and all the information, documents and
 recordings obtained and used in relation to the system.
- Infrastructure and Environment reserves the right to inspect any load. Any loads
 found to be containing items not designated suitable for incineration or recycling
 may be charged a mixed load charge or asked to remove the load from the site. If
 appropriate the Waste Regulator will be notified of waste being transported which
 does not comply with the Waste Management (Jersey) Law (2005).
- 3. Refusal to follow site instructions, WAC and or instructions from staff will result in a customer being asked to leave site. We reserve the right to refuse access to the facility if these rules are not followed. Unacceptable behaviour (including theft, violent, dangerous driving or aggressive incidents) may result in Police intervention.
- 4. We do not accept any hazardous or dangerous waste.
- 5. Customers are <u>not to sort loads in tipping bays</u> as this will cause delays to other users.
- 6. The site speed limit is max 10mph
- 7. All Number plates must be kept clean enough to be read by the camera. Any plate that cannot be read will have to pull in and come to reception.
- 8. Visitors to Bulky Waste are required to wear Hi Vi neon orange, yellow or pink in colour to ensure customers can be seen , Hard Hats and Safety/Suitable Shoes/boots. Tipping Hall High Vis as above and safety/suitable boots/shoes
- 9. Vehicles fitted with stabilizer legs must deploy these when tipping to prevent unbalancing.
- 10. Children and animals must always remain in vehicles when on the site.
- 11. All customers should drive courteously and watch out for other moving vehicles and no person should stand behind a vehicle.





Weighbridge Access and Site Information Site Rules

- 12. The use of mobile phones (unless using a hands free device) and smoking and vaping is not permitted ANYWHERE on site.
- 13. Any items smaller than 1 meter in length/ size of standard 140lt bin bag must only be taken to the tipping hall.
- 14. All items over 1 meter in length/larger than standard bin bag must only be taken to the Bulky Waste Facility where it will be shredded prior to burning.
- 15. No removal of any material from the site is permitted.
- 16. Any vehicle which appears unsafe will be refused entry to site and reported to Driver and Vehicle Standards for inspection. DVS may conduct random inspections of vehicles on the Site.
- 17. Any spillages of waste on access roads and turning aprons must be picked up and disposed of appropriately by the customer delivering the waste. Please inform site staff of the incident. A charge will be levied to cover the cost of cleaning up any spillage not adequately cleaned up by customers.
- 18. Tipping vehicles should sort their loads before tipping and put recyclables in bins provided.
- 19. All users are to have adequate provision to unload their vehicles safely. It is not the responsibility of Infrastructure and Environment to assist unloading heavy or awkward loads. We accept no Responsibility or liability for any damage to customer vehicles using the facility.
- 20. No waiting on the access road outside the gates before 7.30am, this causes dangerous blind bend road use and blocks entry into other businesses. Repeated disregard for this rule will result in admittance being blocked.
- 21. All loads must be covered.





Q&A

What is the purpose of the weighbridge at the Energy Recovery Facility?

The purpose of the Weighbridge registration is to allow you a quick and efficient way of weighing in and out of the La Collette facility using the camera operated weighbridge system.

Who can use the Energy Recovery Facility?

Any customers who have commercial waste once registered with the Facility can use the site. Domestic vehicles carrying household waste should continue to use the Household Recycling Centre at La Collette and other public recycling facilities.

How do I apply to be registered or change and update my current details ie: buy or sell a vehicle, or change address?

Please fill out the online form on gov.je under La Collette commercial recycling and waste disposal

Can I use the site if I haven't registered?

NO – if you do not register with us or do not update your vehicles you cannot enter site.

Why do I need to update my contact details or vehicle registrations?

To be able to access the site the ANPR camera needs to read the number plate and connect it to a company vehicle on the data base. If it is not on the data base access will be denied. The Waste Management Law and Licence states that the Facility must record all waste brought onto site and where it is sourced. By applying for access, you are agreeing to update any details in a timely fashion. If this is not done, then company access could be denied.

What are the opening times?

Monday to Friday 7.30am to 4.15pm – the site is closed all other times. PLEASE DO NOT COME TO SITE BEFORE 7.30AM OTHERWISE QUEUES FORM RESULTING IN EXTREMELY DANGEROUS ROAD BLOCKAGES ON THE SLIP ROAD AND PREVENTING ACCESS TO THE JEC – REPEATED FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS RULE MAY RESULT IN ACCESS BEING TERMINATED.

What can be brought to the ERF?

The Facility's Waste Acceptance Criteria is above

Can I deliver Fire extinguishers and flares to site?

NO! These are incredibly dangerous and MUST not be brought to site.

Are there any charges to deliver waste to site?

Currently there are only charges for certain waste including agricultural polythene and highgrade paper. Please see gov.je for information.
