

Planning and Building (Jersey) Law 2002

Part 6, Chapter 1 - Sites of Special Interest

Application for permission to carry out works or activities that are otherwise prohibited on a Site of Special Ecological / Geological Interest (Ref. DP)

GUIDANCE

Owners and occupiers of land within a Site of Special ecological or geological Interest (SSI) will need to apply for permission to carry out certain works or activities.

The works and activities that require consent differ depending on the SSI – you should check the content of the Management Statement attached to the Notification of Listing that you will have received. Alternatively you can find this information in the Register of Natural SSIs which can be viewed online at <https://www.gov.je/citizen/Planning/Pages/NaturalSites.aspx>.

We will aim to decide whether permission should be granted within 15 working days of receipt of the application and all relevant enclosures. If you are seeking renewal of an existing permission without change, you should contact us and we may be able to re-issue it.

When completing your application please answer all relevant questions and provide full details. We will make a determination based on the information you provide; failure to provide insufficient information may delay the consent process.

Please provide a map showing as accurately as possible the area of land where you wish to undertake works.

The application form should be signed by the landowner or occupier. Where you are not the owner or occupier you can still apply for consent as long as you have written permission from the owner; this can be in the form of their signature on the application or by separate letter which must accompany your application.

We may place conditions on your permission. These are required in order to protect the SSI in which you have requested consent.
