	Marine Resources presented the outcome of the vote to the members:

	As the majority are in favour, it was agreed that the following action would be taken by Marine Resources at the earliest opportunity:	MR		
	<ul> <li>A written communication will be sent to the Minister for the Environment, John Young to notify him that the RMA are in support the need for an independent environmental regulator</li> <li>A written communication will also be sent to the incoming Minister for the Environment</li> </ul>			
	<ul> <li>A written communication will be sent to the Director General, for Infrastructure, Housing and the Environment (to provide assurance for the transition of government)</li> </ul>			
	ERA reiterated that there was a difference between a) ratification of the SOS report that has been presented and b) support for an independent environmental regulator			
	N.B. MR confirmed following the meeting that the vote split is actually 6:2:2 once the tour operators are grouped together as they only get one vote between them

	Update from Marine Resources on the progress made within the RMA Sub-committee. General acceptance of program of habitat and species monitoring discussed during the sub-committee working group			
	<b>Common Eel</b> NT raised concerns over the storm gate valves as a flood prevention matter within Jersey's reservoir system, and potential impact on the population of the common eel, which has a significant freshwater stage. NT are in discussion with Natural Environment	NT		

	on this topic, but would like to establish baseline numbers and propose tracking this species through the SE RAMSAR Management plan.	
	Sea search MR and JMC to meet to discuss the potential use of Sea search dive surveys across the sites and to establish whether there are existing data sets/baseline data for each site and whether they are suitable/could be used as a monitoring mechanism in the future for RAMSAR.	MR
	Marine Litter Concerns raised about old gear, cable ties, rubber bands from aquaculture etc within RAMSAR area. JMC are launching the "70 for 70 countryside to coast incentive scheme" for the Queen's Jubilee incentivising the public to bring 70 pieces of litter for a small reward. It was suggested that we should promote the use of washing machine filters (outflows capturing microplastics) – perhaps this could be an incentive, although could be too costly	JMC
	<b>Education</b> BLUE suggested they have a strong comms team/network and are happy to put MR in touch to talk through future comms strategy for RAMSAR. BLUE also suggested linking in with Visit Jersey who run scheduled social media campaigns with target audiences. EPJ suggested engaging with Digital Jersey for support and JKA suggest creating a hashtag that could be used to tag and promote RAMSAR work (key strap lines etc)	ВМ

The main concerns being contamination entering the sea at the SE Coast Ramsar site waters for many years to come
