
## **Road Closure**





## Mont Millais and Bagatelle Road (A6), St Helier

**Resurfacing Works** 

Transport and Technical Services (TTS) will be undertaking essential maintenance works on this major arterial route into and out of St Helier to provide road-users with a good quality, durable road surface.

Reason: Resurfacing of the road owing to its

poor condition and ride quality, last carried out at least 23 years, and in

some cases, 32 years ago.

Start Date: Monday 20 July 2009

(start of school holidays)

**Duration:** Approximately 6 weeks

(to finish before school term starts)

Working 9:30am to 4:30pm Hours: Monday to Friday

Access: When works are in progress, no

through traffic is permitted: Access to premises will be maintained at all times by arrangement with the

contractor.

Diversion: Works will be carried out under a

road closure between the working hours shown. The diversion routes will be signposted and are indicated

on the plan opposite.

Traffic travelling from St Martin is encouraged to use St Saviour's Hill and traffic from Princes Tower Road to use Wellington Road. This is to minimise disruption. Those driving uphill are asked to use Wellington

Road or St Saviour's Hill.

Heavy Goods Vehicles, especially P30 vehicles, must use the Ring Road via Rouge Bouillon and

St Saviour's Hill.

Bus Routes: Bus route numbers 3 and 3a will be following the diversion along

be following the diversion along Wellington Road during site working hours. Temporary bus stops will be

provided.

TTS and A Le Sech (Asphalt) Ltd regret the inconvenience that these essential maintenance works will cause and ask the motoring public to avoid the area if possible or allow more time for their journeys. Please work with us to minimise disruption by following the carefully considered diversion routes.
