DECLARATION OF SPECIAL MEASURES: CHRONIC WASTING DISEASE

Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016

The Minister for the Environment

- a. has reasonable grounds for suspecting the existence of chronic wasting disease in the United States of America, Canada, South Korea, Norway, Sweden, and Finland, such that certain animals and products originating in or dispatched from these territories are liable to pose risk to human or animal health.
- b. In exercise of the powers conferred under Regulation 15 of the EU Legislation (Veterinary and Zootechnical Checks – Trade with Member States) (Jersey) Regulations 2016, and by regulation 11 of the EU Legislation (Veterinary Checks- Imports from Third Countries (Jersey) Regulations 2016 the Minister for the Environment declares the following special measures to be necessary in Jersey in order to contain the risk to human or animal health:

1. Suspension of entry of certain products into Jersey

1.1 Entry into Jersey is suspended for the following animals and products originating in or dispatched from the United States of America, Canada, South Korea, Norway, Sweden, or Finland:

- a. urine hunting lures derived from cervids;
- b. live cervids;
- c. fresh cervid meat, except where accompanied by veterinary certificate RUF or RUW and produced from meat that complies with the supplementary guarantee for chronic wasting disease provided in the certificate.¹

Interpretation

2. In paragraph 1 of this Declaration:

- a. 'cervids' means animals of the family *Cervidae*;
