COFFEE CUPS AND LIDS

Single-use coffee cups are lined with plastic so can't be recycled. Buy a keep-cup to take with you. You might even get a discount.



PLASTIC BOTTLES

Plastic bottles can last for 450 years in the marine environment, they slowly fragment into smaller pieces but never truly go away. Choose refillable options.



PLASTIC BAGS

On average a plastic bag is used for twelve minutes. Take your own reusable bags and keep spares at work, home and in the car.

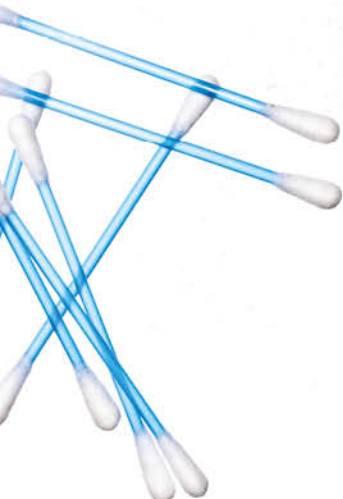
STATIONERY

When you are buying stationery look for reusable, refillable or plastic free alternatives.



BATHROOM PLASTICS

33% of plastic is used once and then discarded. Source plastic free alternatives to replace disposable razors, liquid soap, deodorant and cotton buds.



PLASTIC CUTLERY AND STRAWS

Carry a cutlery roll with you. Include a knife, fork, spoon, tea-spoon and reusable straw rolled into a fabric napkin and you're all set to go!

- The home waste challenge – collect all the recyclable and non-recyclable plastics used at home over a one-week period. Document what you've got and think about how you can reduce it. Challenge yourself to reduce it by 50% (or even more!).
- Use your consumer power – support businesses who are consciously reducing their plastic use. Encourage other shops to join in too.
- Waste free lunches. When you're packing a picnic or a lunch box go waste free. Pack your lunch in reusable containers saying no to cling film, and plastic bags.
- Join in with a beach clean or organise your own. Maybe make a pledge to pick up 3 plastic items from the beach, park or country lane each time you go.
- Make sure you recycle what you can. If you have kerbside recycling use it and take your other recyclables to La Collette. If you haven't got kerbside recycling ask your Parish to set it up.
- Encourage your work, school, clubs or other organisations to get involved. Be the voice for change.
