Ministerial engagement with Jersey Reds:

* Meeting on 10th November 2022, Deputy Stephenson and the head of local economy - met with Jersey Reds at their request

* Jersey Reds expressed their desire to play in the Premiership and noted their hope for recurring Government grants to achieve this.

* Deputy Stephenson made clear that long-term/ recurring funding was not factored into the existing Economy budget and that Jersey Reds would need to manage their spend appropriately

* Importantly there was no indication from Jersey Reds that they were in short-term financial difficulty

* Email to CEO on 23rd January – Jersey Reds contact CEO Suzanne Wylie to request urgent funding of 250k with a further 250k later in 2023 to avert short term financial challenges.

* This request is passed onto officers and Ministers who draft a reply to be sent my the Minister with respons bility for Sport.

* Letter on 26th January 2023 (attached), Deputy Stephenson replied to a Jersey Reds request made to the CEO for funding of 500k (250k immediately and a further 250k during 2023).

* Deputy Stephenson (after discussion with MEDTSC and officers) highlighted the previous government support provided and made it clear that it was not possible to underwrite further support and explained that as Minister it was important to ensure an even-handed approach to sport report rather than disproportionately supporting rugby in particular.

* Deputy Stephenson's letter included an offer to meet in person to discuss further. This was not taken up.

* Meeting with officers 16th March – Jersey Reds meet with officers from Treasury and Economy to discuss the Club's finances following Deputy Stephenson's letter. Treasury requested further information to understand the Club's financial position in depth.

* Call to Director, Treasury and Investment Management 23rd June (Friday), Jersey Reds (Mark Chown) contacted Simon Hayward to advise that in the absence of any Government Support the Reds would enter administration on 30th June. The Minister for Treasury and Resources, MEDTSC and AMEDSTC were advised and a meeting with Santander was set up for first thing on the following Monday to understand the situation.

* MEDTSC and Deputy Stephenson met with Santander on 26th June (Monday) - Ministers requested that Santander suggest that they undertake an urgent audit of Jersey Reds financial position to understand the medium/ long term viability of the club.

* Treasury Minister had a separate call with Santander 26th June – Treasury Minister had a separate call with Santander as a follow-up to the above

* Treasury officers have a call with Santander 26th June – Treasury officers meet with Santander following Ministerial meetings. Santander agreed to undertake a review of the Club's financial viability and, in the immediate term to provide urgent financial support (220k) on the proviso that Government agree to re-imbursement.

* TRM, MEDTSC and AMEDTSC agreed to this course of action on 27th June (emails attached).

* Officers meet with Santander 7th July - Officers from Treasury and Economy meet with Santander as part of their work to review the Club's finances and its medium/ long term viability.

* Officers meet with Santander 19th July – Officers from Treasury and Economy meet with Santander as part of their work to review the Club's finances and its medium/ long term viability.

* Meeting with Santander 20th July, TRM and Deputy Stephenson meet with Santander to understand their analysis of Jersey Reds financial position.

* This analysis is subsequently considered and challenged by Treasury and Economy officers and forms the basis of the CoM paper attached.

* Meeting with Jersey Reds and Santander 30th August – TRM, MEDTSC, Deputy Stephenson alongside officers meet with Jersey Reds and Santander to discuss funding for Jersey Reds and long-term funding for the Club.

* Ministers explain that any long-term commitment will need to be considered by CoM

* It is understood that 590k will be required during 2023 to meet the Club's cashflow constraints (this includes the 220k provided in June and subsequent 150k noted below).

* Jersey Reds emphasise that 150k is required in the immediate term to meet the Clubs cashflow needs

* Following the meeting with the Reds, MEDSTSC requested a separate meeting with primary investor **Control**) – dates offered from 18th September onwards (due to Ministerial availability). **Control** agreed date of 23rd October due to his own planned annual leave.

* Letter of instruction and letter of comfort issued 30th August to action a further grant of 150k to Jersey Reds.

* Letter of instruction and letter of comfort issued by MEDTSC and TRM respectively to provide for a 150k payment directly to the Jersey Reds.

* This grant was to provide immediate support for the Club to allow for the financial viability assessment and subsequent CoM consideration to be completed.

* Council of Ministers meeting 19th September – (paper attached) Ministers discussed future funding for Jersey Reds and decided not to proceed with additional support.

* Ministers considered a request from Jersey Reds for support of 590k (minus the 370k already provided) and a further 300k in the 2024/25 season to sustain their operations.

* A business plan was prepared by Jersey Reds, in association with Santander International. A number of assumptions within which were challenged by Ministers and officers, in particular:

* The assumption of 1,000,000 revenue in 2024/25 and 2025/26 from RFU vs c.150,000 in preceding years without contractual foundation. This was deemed an overly optimistic assessment, it was noted that should a new arrangement fail to materialise Jersey Reds would see further funding gaps of c.850,000 from as early as the 2024/25 season.

* A cumulative cost challenge of 350,000 starting immediately and continuing through to 30-Jun-26 was noted as speculative and non-specific

Ministerial engagement with Jersey Reds:

* Meeting on 10th November 2022, Deputy Stephenson and the head of local economy - met with Jersey Reds at their request

* Jersey Reds expressed their desire to play in the Premiership and noted their hope for recurring Government grants to achieve this.

* Deputy Stephenson made clear that long-term/ recurring funding was not factored into the existing Economy budget and that Jersey Reds would need to manage their spend appropriately

* Importantly there was no indication from Jersey Reds that they were in short-term financial difficulty

* Letter on 26th January 2023 (attached), Deputy Stephenson replied to a Jersey Reds request made to the CEO for funding of 500k (250k immediately and a further 250k during 2023).

* Deputy Stephenson (after discussion with MEDTSC and officers) highlighted the previous government support provided and made it clear that it was not possible to underwrite further support and explained that as Minister it was important to ensure an even-handed approach to sport report rather than disproportionately supporting rugby in particular.

* Deputy Stephenson's letter included an offer to meet in person to discuss further. This was not taken up.

* Meeting with officers 16th March – Jersey Reds meet with officers from Treasury and Economy to discuss the Club's finances following Deputy Stephenson's letter. Treasury requested further information to understand the Club's financial position in depth.

* Call to Director, Treasury and Investment Management 23rd June (Friday), Jersey Reds (Mark Chown) contacted Simon Hayward to advise that in the absence of any Government Support the Reds would enter administration on 30th June. The Minister for Treasury and Resources, MEDTSC and AMEDSTC were advised and a meeting with Santander was set up for first thing on the following Monday to understand the situation.

* MEDTSC and Deputy Stephenson met with Santander on 26th June (Monday) - Ministers requested that Santander undertake an urgent audit of Jersey Reds financial position to understand the medium/ long term viability of the club.

* Treasury Minister had a separate call with Santander 26th June – Treasury Minister had a separate call with Santander as a follow-up to the above.

* Treasury officers have a call with Santander 26th June – Treasury officers meet with Santander following Ministerial meetings. Santander agreed to undertake a review of the Club's financial viability and, in the immediate term to provide urgent financial support (220k) on the proviso that Government agree to re-imbursement.

* TRM, MEDTSC and AMEDTSC agreed to this course of action on 27th June (emails attached).

* Officers meet with Santander 7th July – Officers from Treasury and Economy meet with Santander as part of their work to review the Club's finances and its medium/ long term viability.

* Officers meet with Santander 19th July – Officers from Treasury and Economy meet with Santander as part of their work to review the Club's finances and its medium/ long term viability.

* Meeting with Santander 20th July, TRM and Deputy Stephenson meet with Santander to understand their analysis of Jersey Reds financial position.

* This analysis is subsequently considered and challenged by Treasury and Economy officers and forms the basis of the CoM paper attached.

* Meeting with Jersey Reds and Santander 30th August – TRM, MEDTSC, Deputy Stephenson alongside officers meet with Jersey Reds and Santander to discuss funding for Jersey Reds and long-term funding for the Club.

Dear Mark,

Thank you for your email to Suzanne Wylie of the 23rd January.

I have discussed your request in detail with Deputy Morel and Government officers and I appreciate that a decision is a matter of urgency for you and your Board. As the Assistant Minister responsible for Sport I regret that at this point I am minded not to support your request for emergency funding and Deputy Morel is aligned to this decision.

As the records show, Government has historically been a strong financial supporter of Jersey Reds since your promotion to the Championship back in 2012. It is my understanding that the most recent grant of £450,000 was awarded to Jersey Reds for the purpose of "securing professional rugby in Jersey". The purpose of this grant was to enable Jersey Reds to become financially sustainable over an extended three-year period after which no further Government support would be required. These grants were very much made on account of the Government recognising the value that rugby brings to the island both socially and economically whilst also wishing to see your business achieve financial sustainability.

In addition to cash grants, Government has worked to support the Jersey Reds through the difficulties of the Covid period, where your fixtures were suspended and finances were impacted as a consequence. This support extended to guaranteeing a £500,000 small business loan with Santander through to deferring Social Security, GST and ITIS payments which currently account for a debt to Government of almost £300,000 for these items combined.

When we met with yourself and Mark Morgan on the 10th November 2022 you asked about the ability to access further grants and I explained that there was no funding allocated in the current Government Plan. In that meeting I was appraised of the Reds' desire to build a squad designed to win the Championship by 24/25, with aspirations to be promoted and play in the Premiership. You also updated me on your fundraising efforts with High Value Residents, the facility challenges the club was facing and the impending split from Jersey Rugby Club, formally separating the amateur and the professional clubs.

I left that meeting with no indication that there was an imminent financial crisis in the making and feedback at the closing of the meeting was a recommendation that Jersey Reds needed to

manage their spend appropriately; that Jersey Reds should continue to fundraise with HNW individuals and build their cash position, and: that Jersey Reds reconsider the timing of their ambition as the Premiership was in disarray and subject to significant restructuring in the season/s ahead.

I am aware of the structural issues that exist within professional rugby at present however I also need to be even-handed in my approach to the development of all sports in Jersey and what they are able to deliver back to community. It is increasingly difficult to support a single sport disproportionally and against a backdrop of a need for continued financial support. I am happy to meet in person to discuss the above if you feel that would be of benefit.

ORAL QUESTION FOR TUESDAY 3rd OCTOBER 2023 (To be answered by the Minister in person under Standing Order 13(3A))

Deputy R.S. Kovacs of St. Saviour will ask the following question of the Minister for Economic Development, Tourism, Sport and Culture –

"Given the recent success of the Jersey Team at the Worlds Bowls Championships, alongside other sports clubs securing medals at world class championships, will the Minister confirm if clubs that represent the Island on a high level are awarded the same level of funding as Jersey Reds; and will he further provide a breakdown of what the £370,000 provided to Jersey Reds was intended for?"

Answer

I am incredibly proud of the recent successes of local athletes and sporting clubs, and was delighted to be part of the recent Island Games in Guernsey.

Members will be aware that I have committed to a review of Government's delivery of sports policy which will be published later this year. This will identify where delivery of sport can be improved to better support clubs and athletes across all sporting disciplines.

I will also be producing an Elite Sport Strategy which will seek to identify how we can support and fund pathways for local athletes in a fair and even way across sports.

With regards to Jersey Reds, two payments were made during 2023.

The first of these was in June and consisted of £130,000 to meet June wage costs, with an additional £90,000 provided for other immediate costs.

A further payment of £150,000 was made directly by Government in August to meet the Club's urgent cashflow constraints and underwrite operations until September.

The Council of Ministers considered further requests for funding during September and concluded it was not in the best interests of the Island to provide further support.

Supplementary information

Why were the payments made?

It would have been unreasonable to enforce the closure of such a socially valued business without first considering the financial viability of the Club. The short-term funding provided time for a contemporary review of the Club's finances and consideration of its viability in the medium to long term. Following the conclusion of this analysis, the Council of Ministers decided not to proceed with further payments.

Background

The Council of Ministers considered a request from Jersey Reds for a grant of **£590k** (minus the £370k already provided) on September 19th and a further **£300k** in the 2024/25 season to sustain their operations.

A revised business plan was prepared by Jersey Reds, in association with Santander International. A number of assumptions within which were challenged, in particular:

- The assumption of £1,000,000 revenue in 2024/25 and 2025/26 from RFU vs c.£150,000 in preceding years has no contractual foundation and is an optimistic assessment of timing and value of any re-distribution of revenues within the upper tiers of RFU competition. Should a new arrangement fail to materialise Jersey Reds would see further funding gaps of c.£850,000 from as early as the 2024/25 season.
- 2. A cumulative cost challenge of £350,000 starting immediately and continuing through to 30-Jun-26 seems speculative and non-specific

Economic value

Economic Value of Jersey Reds to Jersey's local economy: In 2016, Via Analytics were employed to measure the economic value of Jersey Reds to the wider economy. This independent assessment determined that Jersey Reds made a contribution of $\pounds 1.4 - \pounds 2.1m$ annually. This is largely derived from tax on payroll and fans from visiting clubs travelling to watch their team play in Jersey.

Social Value

This is largely derived through the volume of fans who watch home games. Matchday spectator numbers (c.1,200 last season) have fallen from c.1,500 in 2018/19 and from over 2,000 at home matches in September 2013. Whilst spectator growth is recognised to be challenging in a finite population / catchment area, it is evident that Jersey Reds has actually lost a significant percentage of its local audience.

Wider context

Rugby as a sport has faced serious financial challenges over the past 3 years. The top tier of professional rugby in the UK saw three Premiership Rugby Clubs file for bankruptcy in 2023, reducing the league from 13 to 10 teams. Additionally, the RFU, the governing body of rugby, reduced their annual financial support for Championship (Tier 2) teams from £650k per team pre-covid down to £288k and again in 2022/23 down to £145k.

I am writing to you as I attended a meeting at Broad Street today, 27.9.23., between Deputy Morel, **Control** and **Control** of GOJ, along with Gordon Crawford at which Mr Crawford and I were informed of the Council of Ministers decision on 19.9.23. not to provide further financial assistance to Trading, as previously requested by Trading. There was suggestion that the Council of Ministers ("COM") decision may be reviewed if 150k could be found to meet immediate liabilities, within the subsequent 36 hours, however this was felt to be a remote possibility by Mr Crawford and myself.

Mr Crawford and I are directors of Jersey Reds (2022) Ltd, the investment company that has provided 900k of funding for Trading in the period since June 2022. Neither of us are directors of Trading.

I informed the directors of Trading, Mark Morgan and Brian Morris, of the discussions outlined above, including the COM decision, immediately following the meeting with Deputy Morel. The directors of Trading were concerned why the COM decision on such an important matter was not immediately conveyed, despite multiple requests from Trading for clarification of the situation. They feel that the extended period of delay to learn of the decision curtailed their ability to raise further short-term funds and has made the situation more traumatic than it may have been with immediate notification of the COM decision. Once they learned of the COM decision the directors sought legal advice **Community**. As a result of this advice Trading ceased operation and trading as a business as at 17.30 on 27.9.23. Announcements will be made to staff early on 28.9.23. and subsequently to other interested parties.

I had a call with Mark Chown over the weekend and wanted to provide you with a readout of that call ahead of tomorrow's meeting.

The purpose of the call was to provide constructive feedback following Mark Morgan's email and to facilitate a constructive meeting tomorrow.

The ask from Reds is for 500k over the next 4 months. This is over and above the 220k provided via Santander last month.

This is requested as a grant and the same amount is required in 2024.

What you will hear from Mark and his fellow directors is that the reason the club finds itself in a perilous financial position is not through unmanaged spend and failing to operate within a budget but rather due to a number of failings on the part of the Government.

These were:

- 1 the removal of ongoing grant funding
- 2 Gov encouraging multiple fiscal stimulus bids which were unsuccessful
- 3 Gov failing to deliver on the Island Stadium

There has been little in the way of creative proposals to share the downside / risk of the assumptions in their business plan not materialising (either in the short term or over the next two seasons) and I have suggested that some thought be given to this as Ministers may wish to see risk shared if they are to support financially given that Gov has:

1- provided 450k under the previous Goverment "to secure Championship rugby in Jersey"

2 - deferred c.400k in ITIS, GST etc

- 3 reprofiled the repayment of the above debt from a 12 to a 36-month payment plan and
- 4 underwritten 80% of a 500k Santander payroll loan.

The call ended with a reminder that a failure by Government to find the required cash by the close of business on Wednesday would result in the certain closure of the business. I reiterated the difficulty that emergency payments posed to Treasury and all Departments of Government.

I am on annual leave this week but will be joining the meeting online and M available to speak ahead of the meeting if required.
