Jersey's private sector gas workers should be treated the same as those employed by the state-owned utilities during the coronavirus emergency, Unite the union, urged today (Monday 6 April).

Unite has lent its weight to the campaign for workers at Jersey Gas and Kosangas Jersey to be elig ble for the Phase 2 payroll co-funding scheme – the Channel Island's equivalent of the UK 's coronavirus job retention scheme which guarantees furloughed workers 80 per cent of income.

Jersey Electricity and Jersey Water are owned by the States of Jersey Government, so these workers already receive state support, while privately-owned utilities, currently, don't have access to the scheme.

Unite regional coordinating officer Terry Keefe said: "Unite is lending its support to the gas companies in their bid to qualify for the Phase 2 payroll.

They provide services to about half Jersey's businesses, including hotels and restaurants now closed, and are really under the financial cosh.

"The States government quickly needs to embrace private utility companies in Phase 2 for cash flow reasons to keep them afloat, otherwise our members could find themselves in desperate financial hardship.

"The future provision of gas by a highly skilled workforce will also be under threat.

"This is not the time for the States of Jersey Government to engage in short-termism – we need to retain the gas workers as they will be a vital cog in rebuilding the post-pandemic economy."

Unite has about 60 gas worker members on Jersey.

Dan and I spoke with Ian Plenderleith and , IEG CFO (parent co), on Thursday evening.

We have had some of the financial information we requested but not all of it. We are missing information on IEG's accounts / shareholding and information on the debt position within Jersey Gas / Kosingas.

We informed them that Phase 2 of the Co-Funded Payroll Scheme included an exclusion in respect to their sector. We also discussed that:

- * there may be an opportunity for them to access the special situations fund, but we needed to have an understanding of what their requirements for assistance were and when this might be required
- * they should speak both to their shareholders regarding sources of funding / equity injections and to existing lenders (both internal if group related debt, and external) regarding options for varying / extending existing terms and additional financing to cover cash flow shortfalls
- * Jersey Gas should be able to access the business disruption loan guarantee scheme

They have 3 main concerns:



The third stems from a mix of the first and general uncertainty over the future.

They were going to take this away and talk with their board. We did reiterate that government support should be the last resort and that we would expect them to have exhausted other options first.

Dan and I have both been contacted by Ian Plenderleith again this morning requesting a short call this morning. Do let me know if you would like to be involved.


Hi Lyndon,

This is a not unexpected escalation by Jersey Gas at a time when they have not yet provided us with the information previously requested to help with consideration of their case.

We have had some of the financial information we requested, but not all of it. We are missing information on IEG's accounts / shareholding and information on the debt position within Jersey Gas / Kosingas.

We informed them that Phase 2 of the Co-Funded Payroll Scheme included an exclusion in respect to their sector. We also discussed that:

- * there may be an opportunity for them to access the special situations fund, but we needed to have an understanding of what their requirements for assistance were and when this might be required
- * they should speak both to their shareholders regarding sources of funding / equity injections and to existing lenders (both internal if group related debt, and external) regarding options for varying / extending existing terms and additional financing to cover cash flow shortfalls
- * Jersey Gas should be able to access the business disruption loan guarantee scheme



The third stems from a mix of the first and general uncertainty over the future. They were going to take this away and talk with their board. We did reiterate that government support should be the last resort and that we would expect them to have exhausted other options first.

I spoke again to Ian Plenderleith again this afternoon and reiterated the need for all necessary information to be forthcoming before we could consider there request for financial assistance. Once we have all the information I'll forward a consideration paper and recommendation.

I spoke to Ian Plenderleith again last night, just before he went into a meeting with his shareholders.

So, we are in live conversations with Jersey Gas reference their exact needs and have told them that in order to progress their request we require full details of their financial position, including broader IEG information, details of their debt structure (is their debt internal or external) and clarity on exactly what their proposal for support includes. Once we have this we can make an assessment of their situation and provide some water-tight advice with a recommendation as to whether their case should be submitted to the Special Situations Fund. We are still awaiting some of this information, which I am chasing today.

I would suggest that until we have received the necessary data and completed our assessment we should hold-fire on a meeting, but send a holding response along the lines of thanking them for their letter and that the Minister understands their concerns and the urgency of the situation, but that he is aware of and pleased that Jersey Gas and officers are undertaking a financial needs assessment and that he will be happy to discuss the situation once the necessary due diligence has been completed.

Good Afternoon,

Please find below statement on a Jersey Gas statement which was issued today:

The Government of Jersey is aware of the proposed increase to local gas prices of 6.5%, following the publication of a press release from Jersey Gas this morning. The company alleges that they are unable to access government support for their business, its customers and its staff during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Ministers have expressed disappointment that Jersey Gas continue to conduct discussions on financial support through the media rather than directly with the Government.

Jersey Gas has chosen not to provide Government with vital financial information on their business and their parent company, which has been requested on multiple occasions. This information is a necessity to progress any applications for government support during this crisis.

Jersey Gas is owned by Isle of Man based International Energy Group, which is in turn owned by a private equity fund. Before committing taxpayer support, the Government needs to understand what investor or lender support has already been sought by IEG and its owners, and why Jersey Gas does not have access to sufficient working capital of its own. This information has also not been received from Jersey Gas.

The Minister for Economic Development, Senator Lyndon Farnham, commented:



"The overarching aims of our government support schemes are to ensure businesses do not close, Islanders continue to remain employed, and can maintain their livelihoods. I ask Jersey Gas to engage constructively with Government and to show transparency of financial information and transactions, so a full and considered response can be provided to them as soon as possible. I would urge Jersey Gas not to follow through with the planned increase while discussions are taking place.
"A price increase of this magnitude comes at a time when many Islanders are experiencing financial insecurity and is particularly insensitive. I am not prepared to see islanders suffer added hardship during this difficult time and will consider all steps available to Government – including those provided for under the Jersey Gas Company (Jersey) Law 1989 – to see that Jersey Gas acts appropriately towards all of its stakeholders".
