<u>Updat</u>	<ul> <li>te progress since last meeting –</li> <li>Took the substance use strategy to the council of ministers, this was generally supported by the minsters</li> <li>Two key areas to reconsider, 1:</li> <li>2: alcohol policy</li> <li>– on secondment from UK civil service, has been tasked to map out what the position is in Jersey. In terms of regulation information required, how many people are being prescribed medicinal cannabis, how much are they being prescribed/from where.</li> <li>Prescriptions sent to the chief pharmacist need to be audited so data can be collected/analysed for evidence to support a regulatory system. From this meeting today would like opinion how we can put the regulation in place.</li> </ul>
