Re: Your first trimester screening results

You recently had the 'combined test' to screen for Down's, Edward's and Patau's syndrome. This has shown that your baby has a lower chance of having these conditions. Your individual chances for this pregnancy are as follows:

Down's syndrome 1 chance in [redacted]

Edward's and Patau's syndrome 1 chance in [redacted]

***For example:** to help you understand what this means imagine a group of the above number of women. One woman will be pregnant with a baby that is affected by a chromosomal syndrome.*

We do not offer further testing at this level. A lower chance result does not mean that there is no chance at all that the baby has Down's, Edward's or Patau's syndrome, just that it is unlikely.
