Subject: Subsidy for the sampling of PFAS in private water supplies.			
Decision(s): The Minister approved the provision of sampling of PFAS for households with private drinking water supplies.			
Reason(s) for Decision: The Government regularly samples PFAS in water and will shortly commence a hydrogeological survey of St Ouen's Bay and Pont Marquet catchment. Information from other sampling points will increase the understanding of the behaviour and distribution of PFAS. Households using private water supplies can apply to have their water tested and for the Government to fund/part fund the cost of analysis.
