Dear Lyndon

Senator Ozouf and [REDACTED] have previously been provided with a redacted copy of the report. We had discussed publication with what we understood to be CICRA's appropriate Ministerial contact to ensure they were aware of the intention to publish a Statement on First Stage Findings (a near final version of which was provided by [REDACTED] last week). I am sorry that this was not then communicated to you, we understood Senator Ozouf to be our main ministerial contact.

The information on which we have based our findings was provided voluntarily by the fuel companies, without the need to request formal information gathering powers. I am sure that you appreciate that most of this information is commercially sensitive; we are legally obliged to redact such information prior to publication. With the need to make such significant redactions publishing a Statement on the First Stage Findings is a more appropriate way to communicate the results of the study at this stage.

I am due to meet with [REDACTED] next week to discuss next steps, please can you confirm who should be the main ministerial contact for this work going forward?
