Ministers,

[REDACTED] from Visit Jersey and I met [REDACTED] his colleagues yesterday to discuss the Dance World Cup 2016.

We will have to agree how we support the DWC which will, without question, be a major event in the 2016 calendar. I will be recommending that we form a 'committee' and nominate a lead person to bring together representatives from the different bodies and departments to have regular meetings to ensure that there is an understanding and accountability for various aspects of the organisation. It is not like the Natwest Island Games because the event is being run by a Private Company, but it is vital that all parties work together to make it a successful event for all involved. There is a major opportunity to enhance Jersey's reputation but we must mitigate the risks which may cause the opposite.

The 2015 event will be held in Romania in the same week as the Natwest Island Games - June 28th to July 4th. [REDACTED] is arranging to get a page in the programme which will 'advertise' Jersey. The deadline for this is May 1st but she is confident this can be achieved.

The other major impending issue is to identify someone to go to collect the flag on behalf of Jersey and to say a few words at the closing ceremony. This will require travelling on Friday

2nd July and returning Sunday 5th. Anyone going will need to leave before the closing ceremony of the Natwest Island Games. This is a much lower key event than the opening ceremony. [REDACTED] offering to pay for these expenses if we need this to happen.

Are any of you inclined to 'volunteer' to go to Romania for a couple of days? If not, who should we ask?

The other fairly urgent thing to do is to follow up with Condor on the transport from St Malo. I know that [REDACTED] met with them but I think it would be good to have a better indication of what they might be able to do before the event this year. [REDACTED] or a representative from [REDACTED] will be going to Romania for a couple of days and making presentations to the dance teachers to talk about accommodation. Based on my experience of the Natwest Island Games, I believe this will be very valuable exercise and hopefully will result in many commitments from potential visiting groups. Having an idea about transport will be very helpful, I think

Please let me know your thoughts, especially about a person who could represent Jersey in Romania.

Collecting the 'flag' I see as really important and it should be collected by a politician if possible.

I would love to go and get it but the timing is awful in regards to the Island Games. Leaving on Friday is not possible for me and possibly most States Members but when is the actual flag collecting ceremony?

We also need to discuss this on Friday.

This week Jersey has hosted the NatWest Island Games featuring nearly 3000 participants in 14 sports from 24 Islands from all over the World.
