I am sure the candidates will have noticed there has been a certain amount of controversy about the site for the new hospital. Notwithstanding the inspector's rejection of the planning application, the Health Minister, who is with us this evening, continues to insist that there is only one site which meets the island's requirements. But when Atkins reported on the list of 41 sites at the outset, they thought that the Warwick Farm site "could be considered the preferred option, particularly regarding the longer term view of the hospital and its flexibility in responding to issues in the 40-50 years hence." These views weren't put to the States when they voted on 2016.

Against that background, my question to the candidates is "Do the candidates think that building the new general hospital on the site of the existing hospital is sensible without allowing the new States which is to be elected in two weeks' time to consider the question and look at the other sites in the parish of St Helier before a final decision is taken in September and October?"

My second question is to you Mr Chairman, at the end of the answers, would it be possible just to have a show of hands, those in favour of building on the old site and those who would like to have a second thought about it?

The hospital is one of those really difficult decisions that the next Assembly has got to make and stick with and not keep looking over its shoulder and wondering "if only there were another site that were better." We know what the planning inspector said about the site, we know that another application has been submitted so, I know [REDACTED] you don't agree with me, but I think we should get the planning inspector's view of the new site and although I've been criticised this evening for saying, I then expect the new health minister to seek endorsement of the Assembly of that planning application, I absolutely do.

When we asked the public, the public were absolutely split down the middle, 50% said yes they thought it was a good site and 50% said no - and this is the difficulty that the next States is going to have to make a decision on because the current hospital is not fit for purpose and now is the time that we need to build the new hospital.

The letter [REDACTED] has attached raises serious concerns which I set out below. I will finish the response to [REDACTED] open letter today. I would not want to put Dep Pamplin in a difficult position. It would be helpful if you could clarify with Kevin if he is content with the letter being made public [REDACTED] has said [REDACTED] will post your response).

It is of great concern to me that [REDACTED] (and presumably [REDACTED] and possibly others) have this letter and you and Kevin do not. The letter blows apart what these individuals have been describing as the work of the French company. It looks simply like a bid for work by the back door that is compromising a number of parties including the French company.

The French Company have written (perhaps wrongly) to Deputy Pamplin as head of scrutiny. One would think, however, that something as important as this should have been passed on to you. Perhaps you could ask him why he did not provide you with a copy of the letter? I have attached a copy for you at the base of this email

As Health and Social Services Minister I have not received a copy of the letter you attach. It would be for the Chair of the Panel to decide which correspondence he would want to share with me.

I am grateful for your copy of the letter you have provided. It raises a number of serious issues of governance.

- I am unclear of the process by which correspondence between the French company and the Scrutiny Panel chair is in your possession.

- It is not clear to me how and by whom the chair of the Future Hospital Scrutiny Panel was identified as the appropriate recipient of such a letter. Nor is it clear how in copying to other members of the Panel the company sought to advance their commercial interests by engaging with a scrutiny political process rather than a site selection process that appears to be the purpose of their bid for work. The political lead for the Project is

the Minister for Infrastructure and the Senior Responsible Officer and chair of the Future Hospital Project Board is the Director General for Growth Housing and Environment. Either of these would have been a more appropriate contact from whom to seek advice.

- The States of Jersey procurement rules discourage informal and officially unsolicited approaches from contractors. Probity, transparency and fairness to other contractors can be at risk if those making such approaches are not guided through the appropriate procurement process where the details can be recorded and audited. While I do not doubt the bone fides of the company the States of Jersey procurement rules has a specific requirement whereby these bone fides are recorded and checked before formal commercial engagement starts.

- There is a risk that the manner in which the French company has been encouraged to engage with the Future Hospital site selection project thus far might compromise its commercial position should there be States of Jersey tender opportunities in relation to the project in the future


- The company describes visiting two Heath and Community Services operating hospitals (and I presume a third if they have also visited the General Hospital). They have undertaken these visits without seeking the necessary permissions. These hospitals are public buildings and have relatively open access to the public. However when contractors visit sites for commercial purposes they do so with the necessary permissions, with a purpose and method agreed in advance and are generally accompanied by an appropriate member of staff. This approach is designed to protect the safety of patients and staff and the contractor. I suspect similar governance processes would be set out by the current tenants of Warwick Farm.

- The sites described in the letter omit Waterfront options. I have no record of the brief given to the company or who has provided them with the scope of their works. This would include the sites to be appraised and the criteria by which such appraisal is to be conducted. It is not the contractor who decides which sites are to be appraised. This is the responsibility of the States of Jersey.

- My understanding of the visit made to Plerin Hospital 8 November 2018 was that the individuals attended in a private capacity paying all their own expenses. They did not do so on behalf of the States of Jersey. Nor did they do so as part of the work of the Future Hospital Policy Board.

- I have been made aware second hand of a number of supposed conclusions and propositions arising from the French company (the current site is not suitable, the hospital can be build quicker and more cheaply and so on). I have not been provided with first hand evidence for these positions directly from the company.

- Finally the letter sets out how the French company wishes to engage with the States of Jersey after the proposed Assembly debate on the continuance of work to build a new hospital on the site approved by the Assembly in 2016.
