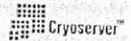

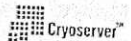
We are going to need to move fast if we are to avoid a massive row.

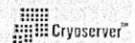

You may be aware that the Council had a challenging States debate about the Gas last week. The Council of Ministers is considering a number of next steps at its meeting this Wednesday.

Ministers have been alerted to issues concerning the Fuel Farms at both the Airport and the Harbours by a number of correspondents.

As you are aware there is public concern about energy prices in both UK and Jersey. We have ongoing reviews concerning the Energy markets and Prices.

Ministers have placed a high priority on ensuring energy markets are working in the interests of consumers, whilst understanding there are important safety and security considerations. Ministers are also unclear as to whether any complaints have actually been made to concerning fuel markets.

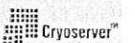
