Dear Deputy Le Hegarat

We were listening to Channel 103 news at 5pm today and had a bit of a chuckle at your comments about the Chief Minister not being in the States today due to being fog bound on Sunday.

My family and I were also fog bound and we only managed to get home yesterday evening by getting a train from Gatwick to Southampton otherwise we would of been on the 7am Easyjet flight today or the last Easyjet flight of the day.

It was absolute chaos at Gatwick on Sunday with all 3 Easyjet flights plus the BA flights to Jersey cancelled. We were on the last flight of the day and were boarded and then told of the fog in Jersey but Easyjet management decided this flight should go knowing it would return to Gatwick. The decision was made not to fly as the weather got worse.

Adding to the chaos and our stress we were told to go to a hotel that had no rooms actually about 50 people were told to go to this hotel - we finally got to our hotel at midnight.

I asked if Easyjet would put on extra flights and was told "doubt it". So Senator Le Fondre was one of many hundreds of people trying to get home.

It's a bit mad isn't it that we are only 40 minutes away but it takes 48 hours to get home - no airline put on extra flights.

I emailed Lyndon Farnham and he has passed my email to Ports of Jersey but if the CM has missed a States sitting and it made the news maybe the airlines will put on extra flights in future so he can make sittings and we can get to work.
