Future Hospital Planning Application

I am writing further to your letter dated 13th December 2018.

In your letter, you ask me some specific questions to which I respond to as follows:

Planning decision timeline

You ask me to set out my proposed timeline for reviewing the Planning Inspector's report and determining the planning application.

I received the Planning Inspector's report on Monday 10th December. I am giving this and other Inquiry documents very careful consideration. I am unable to provide you with a specific date for when I will determine the planning application, but will make a decision as soon as I feel ready to do so. This is most likely to be in January 2019.

Public hearing

I will endeavour to make myself available to attend a public hearing with your Panel once I have made my decision. The timing of such a hearing and my attendance will need to take into account any appeal that might be made against my determination. I am unlikely to be able to attend a public hearing if there is an appeal outstanding.

Announcement of Planning Application decision

You request that I share my planning application decision with you in confidence, at the earliest opportunity.

In accordance with the Planning and Building (Public Inquiries) (Jersey) Order 2008, I am required to publish my determination and the inspector's report, as soon as is practicable after I have determined the application. I am unable to share my decision with your Panel in confidence prior to this.

I intend to notify the applicant of my decision first, and to make my decision public a short while after. In announcing my decision, I will also make public a summary of the reasons for my decision and publish the Planning Inspector's report.

I hope this information is helpful and provides clarity on the process to be followed.
