I understand the sensitivity, and I'm happy to do that.

It might be helpful if we can fully resolve the issue of making good to the site following demolition – this relates to Condition no. 4.

I'm aware that we left the issue hanging slightly with regard to the use of the landside area once the site is cleared. As you will recall, we advised you that we would require a further application for this area to be put to use as additional public parking. I have heard no more from you on this matter, so arguably, the condition is not yet fully discharged.

If you are anticipating a high level of public interest / scrutiny in the project once works are underway, then it would be a good idea for this matter to be fully resolved.
