

The Committee noted a letter, dated 14th November, 1984, from [REDACTED], States Land and Property Officer, regarding Green Island Car Park which the public of the Island leased from the Tenants of the Fief de Crapedoit for the nominal sum of £1 year. [REDACTED] asked whether the Committee wished [REDACTED] to write to [REDACTED], the Chief Tenant, seeking a new agreement for a further 21 years, or whether in the circumstances, negotiations should be entered into for the acquisition of the freehold of the land on which the car park stood.

The Committee, after consideration, decided that the arrangements in respect of Green Island Car Park should continue on the present basis.
