Additional Thoughts

The following points illustrate how this current situation is affecting my family and the enjoyment of our property and of the surrounding area.

As I have previously stated the odours are wind dependent and this is clearly depicted in my diary in regards to when I am out

For the purpose of completing the diary we had to have windows and doors open but in reality this is not possible as the smells infiltrate the house and lingers for a considerable amount of time.

The garden has become totally unusable when the odours are present and washing is unable to be put outside to dry. Our windows now have a light film of grease on them.



We witnessed

on the 28th May 2021, I would like for the record to say that just after that I went to my back wall and I was unable to smell the smells. However, halfway across the garden on my return, I was met with a wall of the smell and then another at my back door and then inside my property.

The smell is intermittent and I can only describe it is like hitting a brick wall when you smell it. Then as you walk through it it disappears. It comes in waves and is not constant. It is extremely unpleasant and is not a smell that makes you feel hungry and that you want to eat something.

I understand that the criteria required for it to be classed as a statutory nuisance is extremely high. Therefore, I do not have any faith that this third investigation will have any different outcome to the previous two. I have made my thoughts to the Minister, which remain unanswered, that I believe this situation should be addressed as a compliance matter. As per the original planning conditions of 1984 which still apply to unit 9 and 10.

I would like it noted that in April we had to endure four days in succession which was very unpleasant. This will no doubt occur again in future months.

Covid-19 advice is telling us to keep our houses ventilated and yet when we experience the smells this is advice that we cannot follow.
