



STATES OF JERSEY POLICE AGREEMENT FOR THE USE OF PHOTOGRAPHS TAKEN IN POLICE CUSTODY

In accordance with National College of Policing guidance, States of Jersey Police, as the legal copyright holder for photographs taken whilst in police custody, are required to impose restrictions on their distribution and use.

By signing this document you (on behalf of the stated media organisation) agree to the following conditions of use:

- That the custody photograph is solely for use in relation to the stated case. Use in relation to other cases will require a separate request.
- That the photograph may only be used if a custodial sentence is passed. If a lesser sentence is passed then all electronic and hard-copies of the photograph must be permanently destroyed.
- When released into your possession prior to sentencing, the photograph is embargoed until a sentence that meets the stated threshold is passed.
- That the photograph is no longer to be used once the individual has been released from prison.
- That the photograph may not be distributed outside of your stated media organisation.

States of Jersey Police reserve the right to withhold release of a custody photograph regardless of sentencing conditions being met.

The individual and media organisation listed below will be held accountable for any failure to comply with the conditions above.
