


Having a baby and the coronavirus vaccine

High risk women that are pregnant or breastfeeding can choose to have the coronavirus vaccine

You must talk to your Doctor first







If you think you might be pregnant you should not get the coronavirus vaccine





If you have the first vaccine and then find out you are pregnant





You should not have the second vaccine until after having the baby

If you are in the High risk group you must talk to your Doctor about having your second vaccine





If you are breast feeding you can choose to wait until you stop breastfeeding before having the vaccine





If you are in the High risk group you can choose to have the vaccine whilst breast feeding

You must talk to your Doctor first
