

If you see any oil around your tank or pipes then:

- Use soil, sand or rags to soak it up.
- Stop oil entering drains by using soil/sand to form a dam.
- Never wash down oil using water or detergents.

You can help stop oil pollution by:

- Regularly checking your tank and pipe work for weaknesses, corrosion or rust.
- Removing any leaves/rubbish from the tank area.
- Keeping the bund watertight, clean, and free of debris.
- Keeping plastic tanks in the shade.
- Replacing old tanks.
- Ensuring that your oil tank and pipe work are professionally surveyed at least once a year.
- Checking the oil level in your tank before ordering more oil.
- Never moving your oil tank when it contains oil.
