Prunus Iusitanica

(Portugal Laurel) Clipped into a formal tabular shape the attractive evergreen leaves of Portugal Laurel create a shady dark green roof. In early summer white flowers appear, smelling sweetly of



**2** Quercus ilex (Evergreen oak) Possibly the most majestic evergreen tree in the Channel Islands. Their leathery, dark and glossy leaves complement the two existing oaks on site.



3 Acer platanoides (Norway maple) The dark green foliage turns clear yellow, sometimes red, in autumn. The large clustered, deep yellow flowers, tinged with red, decorate the tree before the leaves appear.



4 Ulmus 'New Horizon' An excellent medium-sized tree, with balanced, conical crown and dark silky glossy leaves. 'New Horizon' is one of the species which is immune to the Dutch Elm Disease.
