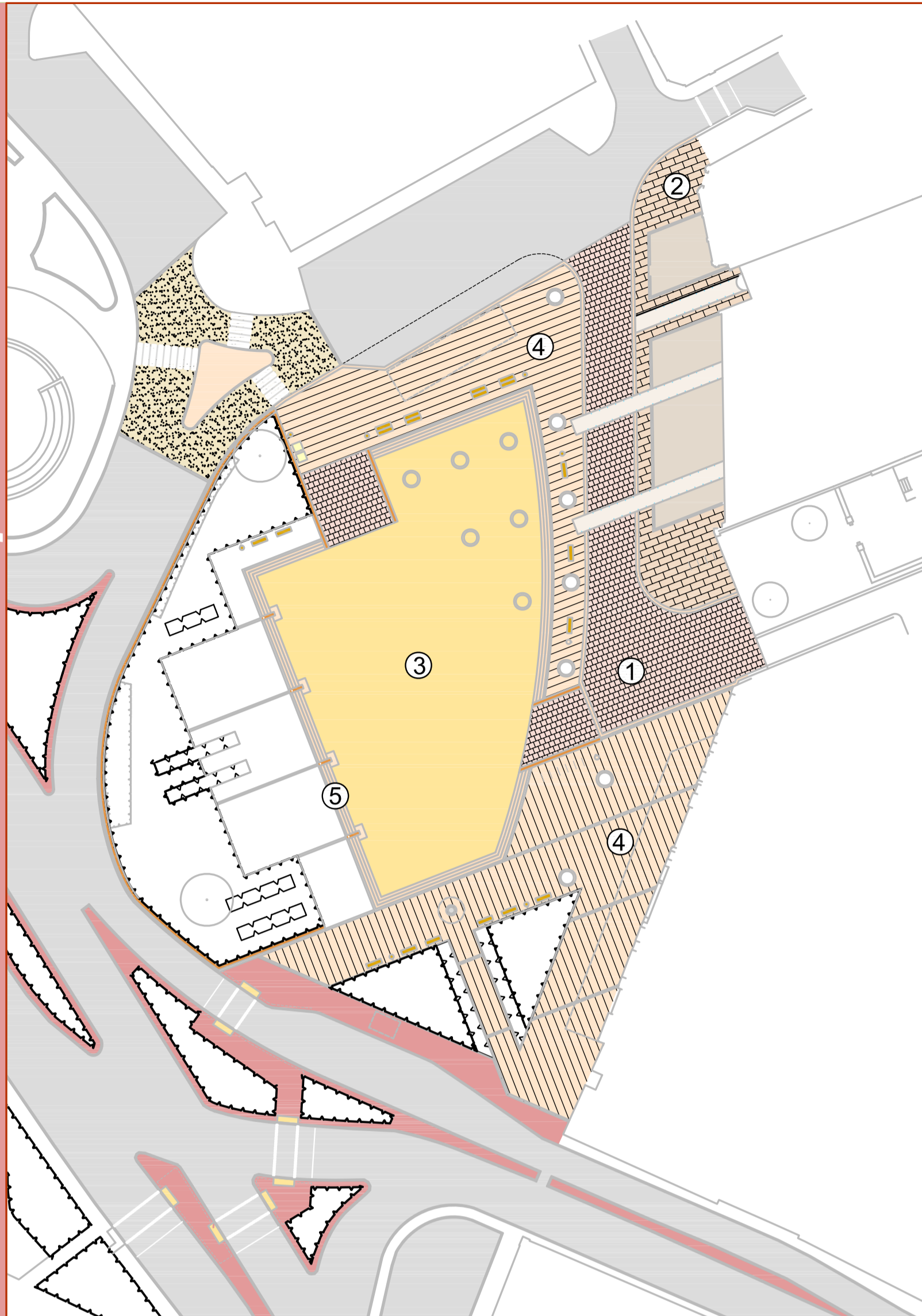
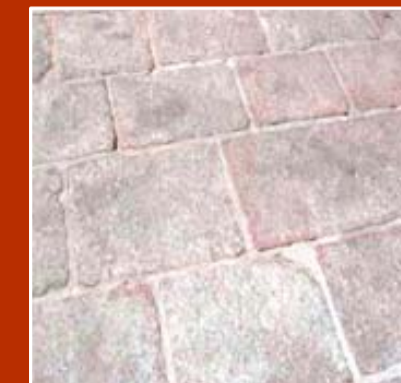

PAVING SPECIFICATION

Realigned 'Caledonia Place'
Reclaimed granite cobbles. Colour: Rosa Peroni, laid to a stretcher bond pattern. 200mm x 140mm x 140mm thick. Paving to match, where possible, existing cobbles in Ordnance Yard.

Pavement in front of Royal Yacht Alfresco Area
Existing granite slabs, lifted from site and re-laid.

General granite paved areas
French granite slabs, bush hammered finish. Colours: Peroni (70%)/Rosa Calarte (20%)/Jean (10%), 75mm thick, laid to a random running bond, 350mm wide coursing x 275/375/450mm long.

Granite trim detail
French granite setts, cropped face. Colour: Rosa Peroni. Laid to a two course trim. 100 x 100 x 100mm thick.

Central open space
Three number high granite steps (150mm riser heights) and two courses of granite setts surround a central open space surfaced in hoggins, 75mm thick.

1 *Prunus lusitanica* (Portugal Laurel)
Clipped into a formal tabular shape, the attractive evergreen leaves of Portugal Laurel create a shady dark green roof. In early summer white flowers appear, smelling sweetly of hawthorn.



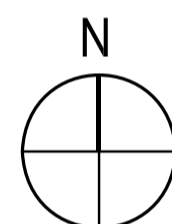
2 *Quercus ilex* (Evergreen oak)
Possibly the most majestic evergreen tree in the Channel Islands. Their leathery, dark and glossy leaves complement the two existing oaks on site.



3 *Acer platanoides* (Norway maple)
The dark green foliage turns clear yellow, sometimes red, in autumn. The large clustered, deep yellow flowers, tinged with red, decorate the tree before the leaves appear.



4 *Ulmus 'New Horizon'* (Elm)
An excellent medium-sized tree, with balanced, conical crown and dark silky glossy leaves. 'New Horizon' is one of the species which is immune to the Dutch Elm Disease.

- Hemerocallis* in purple (Daylily)
- Perovskia* 'Little Spire' (Russian sage)
- Phlomis taurica* (Jerusalem sage)
- Pittosporum tobira* 'Variegatum' & 'Nana' as a low clipped hedge
- Roses in pink and white

Grasses:

- Calamagrostis x acutiflora* 'Karl Foerster' (Feather reed grass)
- Stipa gigantea* (Giant oat grass)
