

What is J.E.L.L.Y Club?

J.E.L.L.Y stands for 'Jersey Early Learning Literacy Years' and has been developed by Parenting Support Services in partnership with Jersey Library.

We welcome pre-school babies and children with their mums, dads, grandparents or carers.

All sessions are run by experienced parenting facilitators and offer a space to meet other families and enjoy time with your child through singing, sharing stories, play and fun, with an emphasis on supporting learning and development in the early years.
