## Consultation: Developing a world-class post-16 education system in Jersey

A vibrant post-secondary education sector is vital for Jersey's future and we want to hear your views on how we can make this a reality.

The number of students in Higher Education in Jersey has been declining and is much lower than other comparable countries and jurisdictions.

A consultation on a vision for post-16 education strategy has been launched by the Government of Jersey to give islanders more opportunity to further their education, whether that is:

- school leavers who are looking to study vocational or academic qualifications in Jersey or abroad
- care leavers who in the past have left school at the age of 16 or, for other reasons, have not progressed to sixth-form study
- the long-term unemployed and mature workers returning to the labour market
- those who are unemployed and have a disability
- people who want to enrol in courses to remain in work or change careers
- providing young people with the skill sets, knowledge and further education they need to be a global citizen wherever they choose to live
- offering more choices and opportunities for all students to make the most of their abilities without labels such as "academic" or "technical" being attached to them
- seeking to establish closer links with relevant UK organisations, universities and abroad
