

Application for Equine Isolation Facility

Animal Health (Importation of Miscellaneous Goods and Animals) (Jersey) Order 2017

Your equine animal is to remain in isolation at the place of destination according to the export health certificate post import from the European Union (EU), till the horse is released by a veterinary Inspector or an Inspector.

This application form is to ensure that the place of destination meets isolation requirements. This is for animal health and welfare reasons so that we do not delay your horse's time in transit any longer by doing paperwork checks at the harbour and unboxing your horse for a health and identification examination.

A Government veterinary officer will normally confirm identity and check the import paperwork within 72 hours of your horse arriving in Jersey.
