DECLARATION OF SPECIAL MEASURES: SHEEP AND GOAT POX

Animal Health (Jersey) Law 2016

Animal Health (Importation of Miscellaneous Goods and Animals) (Jersey) Order 2017

EU Legislation (Veterinary and Zootechnical Checks – Trade with Member States) (Jersey) Regulations 2016

The Minister for the Environment

- a. has reasonable grounds for suspecting the existence of Sheep and Goat Pox in Bulgaria and Romania such that certain animals and products originating in or dispatched from these territories are liable to pose risk to human or animal health.
- b. In exercise of the powers conferred under Regulation 15 of the EU Legislation (Veterinary and Zootechnical Checks – Trade with Member States) (Jersey) Regulations 2016 the Minister for the Environment declares the following special measures to be necessary in Jersey in order to contain the risk to human or animal health:

1. Suspension of entry of certain products into Jersey

1.1 Entry into Jersey is suspended for the following ovine and caprine commodities originating in or dispatched from Bulgaria and Romania.

- a. Fresh and chilled hides and skins
 - b. Germplasm
- c. These safeguard measures supersede equivalent measures published on 09/10/2023 adding Romania and removing Spain.
