ON FARM STORAGE CONDITIONS

- 1 Semen tank to be stored in a locked room, locked cupboard or similar, inaccessible to livestock. Cannot be stored in the dairy.
- 2 Semen storage tank and insemination equipment to be stored hygienically
- 3 The following records to be kept
 - a) Semen deliveries – supplier, date and number of straws
 - b) Semen use – date and ID of cow/heifer inseminated, bull used, collection batch number, name of inseminator.
 - c) Details of any abnormal calf produced from artificial insemination
 - d) Date and quantity of nitrogen deliveries
