Stage 1:

Scoping, research and options

- Scope and develop the evidence base requirements
- Commission reports and studies
- Explore initial strategic issues and options
- Develop Sustainability Appraisal the set of principles which will ensure that a balance is maintained between environmental, social and economic priorities



Stage 2:

Develop draft Island Plan

- Consider consultation responses to issues and options
- > Undertake Sustainability Appraisal
- > Review evidence base
- > Evaluate options
- > Develop draft plan



Stage 3:

Independent examination

- Independent inspector's review of initial draft Island Plan, consultation responses, evidence base and Sustainability Appraisal
- > Examination in public
- Consider independent inspector's report and finalise draft Island Plan




Stage 4:
