- (ii) There were 3 stillbirths in the Island in 2011.
- (iii) The number of marriages performed in the Office of the Superintendent Registrar in 2011 was 161. This was 34 less than in the previous year. A further 170 civil marriages were celebrated in Approved Premises, 8 less than in the previous year. The most popular months for marriages were August (64), June (60) and September (53).
- (iv) During the year 120 couples came to the Island to be married. This is 4 less than in the previous year. The most popular month for visitors was June (26) followed by August (23) and September (19).
- (v) The number of deaths registered in 2011 is 81 less than in the previous year.
