For Parents


- Parents have a growing voice telling us what they think is important in the way services are delivered. For example, parents have been involved in developing the Under 3's Quality Framework
- Parents have been important in making sure that service providers now think about the needs of the whole family rather than thinking about parents and children separately. For example, maternity services have been influenced by the experiences of parents

For People working with Children

- Under 3 providers now have a quality framework to help them deliver consistent, good quality services
- Anyone wishing to, or already working with, children can seek career advice via the new Qualification Framework
- Those working with school age children have guidance on delivering quality services
- Those working with pre-school children are provided with training and support

For Children

- Children are increasingly being asked their views to help shape services. This work continues
- People who provide services for children are aware of the importance of listening to children, allowing them to express their feelings and ensuring that what children say is heard and acted on
