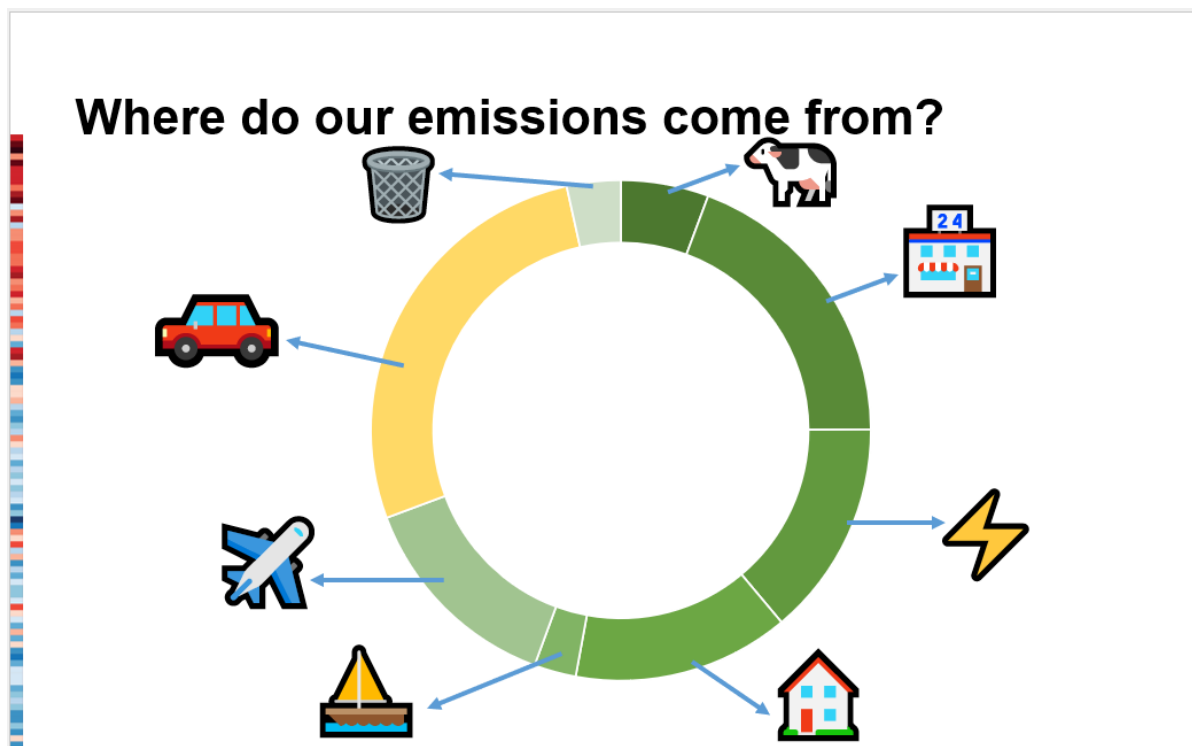
2030 petrol and diesel vehicle phase-out

The approved [Carbon Neutral Roadmap](#) includes a plan to phase-out petrol and diesel vehicles being brought to the Island, from 2030 onwards.

27% of Jersey's greenhouse gas emissions come from road vehicles. The phase-out is needed to reduce these greenhouse gases in response to the climate emergency.

The phase-out will start by changing what happens with cars and small vans. These vehicles make the most impact.

3. Phasing-out petrol and diesel vehicles from 2030

Current plans for Jersey's phase-out mean that cars and small vans (e.g. small business vans used by trades people) that use petrol and diesel fuel, could no longer be brought to the Island. The dates for these changes are set out in the diagram.
