

3. Aims and Benefits of the Proposals

The new Headquarters will provide an efficient, contemporary building designed to support the demands of modern day policing.

The new building will:

- Ensure **more efficient working methods** and better management of resources and equipment
- Provide **enhanced security**: ensuring continuity of operations during major disruptions
- Improve **Custody facilities**: meeting legal and Health and Safety requirements
- Provide offices that can be reconfigured to meet the changing demands of policing for the next 50 years
- Improve command facilities when responding to a **Major Incident**

- Support privacy and segregation of public visitors and detainees, providing **confidential consultation rooms** and a dedicated Public Enquiry Reception
- Provide an eco-efficient building, supporting the environment
- Improve the **working environment** for staff, enhancing productivity and boosting morale
- Enhance **public confidence and trust** in the professionalism of States of Jersey Police

The new site is significantly smaller than the land currently occupied by the Police and will release all of Summerland and a large part of the Rouge Bouillon site for an alternative use, including affordable and social housing.

The construction of the new HQ will stimulate the construction industry during what continues to be a difficult economic time.
