Application to Vary the Terms or Conditions of a Waste Management License

I am writing to apply for a variation to the terms and conditions of Waste Management License WML001, issued by the Department of Environment in December 2013. The variation is to include the provision for receiving and processing waste seaweeds.

The proposed activities include the deposition and treatment of biodegradable municipal garden and parks waste. Seasonal beach cleansing operations undertaken by GHE Highways result in some wastes which are unsuitable for composting under WML003. It would therefore be preferable to treat stranded wrack wastes entirely separately at the La Collette Reclamation Site. The treatment has the additional advantage of resulting in an engineering material to be used at the reclamation site. Increased financial obligations, training, supervision or management are not required of the license holder as a result of this variation.

The enclosed application document should be considered supplementary to the existing working plan and contains:

- Drawings of cell design
- Details of drainage infrastructure
- Acceptance criteria
- Method statements
- Pollution considerations
- Environmental risk assessments

The activities are not considered to have any appreciable adverse effect on the environment when all control measures are utilised as described. This is demonstrated by the results of water quality monitoring which are summarised in the application.
