Management and maintenance of the Havre des Pas site (P.94/2025).

A1. The Council, with reference to its Minute No. A3 of 4th November 2025, received and noted comments on the proposition of Deputy D.J. Warr of St. Helier South, entitled 'Management and maintenance of the Havre des Pas site' (P.94/2025 referred).

The Council recalled that it did not support the proposition, for the reasons set out within the comments, but noted that the Minister for Infrastructure would not oppose Deputy Warr's request for a reduction in the minimum lodging period for this proposition, in order that it could be discussed at the meeting on 11th November 2025 (in accordance with Standing Order 27).

The Council accordingly signalled its support for the comments and requested officers to arrange for them to be presented.
