	Draft Single-use plastics etc. (Restrictions) (Jersey) Amendment No. 2 Law 202- (P.19/2025) It was noted that this proposition of the Minister for Infrastructure would simply correct an error within the Single-use plastics etc. (Restrictions) (Jersey) Amendment Law 202-, which had been adopted by the States Assembly in December 2024, by replacing a reference to the Royal Court with the Magistrate's Court.
