A1. The Council, with reference to its Minute No. A18 of 24th November 2011, gave consideration to the list of public business scheduled for consideration by the States Assembly at the meeting commencing on 6th December 2011. Particular consideration was given to the propositions listed below.

Homebuy or Shared Equity Scheme: approval by the States (P.163/2011)

The Council resolved to support the proposition, having been advised that adoption of P.163/2011 would not compromise the delivery of Homebuy housing on the forthcoming site at La Moye, St. Brelade.

Mobile dental service funded from the Health Insurance Fund (P.170/2011)

The Council understood that the proposer was intending to withdraw his proposition, having received an assurance from the Minister for Social Security that he would seek to address outstanding recommendations made in the related report of the Health, Social Security and Housing Scrutiny Panel concerning dental services (S.R.12/2010 refers).

Health Insurance Fund: transfer to Health and Social Services Department for 2012 (P.185/2011)

The Council endorsed the proposition and noted the intention of the Minister for Health and Social Services to present to the States a comment outlining the governance structure that would regulate the usage of the monies to be transferred.
