Minutes.

A1. The Minutes of the meetings held on 18th December 2013 (Parts A and B); 6th January (Part B only), 15th January (Part A and Part B) and 29th January 2014 (Part A and Part B), having been previously circulated, were taken as read and were confirmed.

With regard to the Minutes of the meetings held on 13th and 27th November 2013, the Chief Minister advised that as a meeting was to be arranged with certain members to discuss issues pertaining to the content of these Minutes, the Minutes would not be confirmed at the present time.

Draft European

A2. The Council discussed the Draft European Union Legislation (Implementat-

ion) (Jersey) Law 201- (P.164/2013), which had been lodged 'au Greffe' by the Minister for External Relations on 16th December 2013.

The Council recalled that the States had agreed to refer the above draft legislation to the Corporate Services Scrutiny Panel for review.

Members concurred with the view of Senator B.I. Le Marquand, Minister for Home Affairs that the matter should have been considered and discussed by the Council of Ministers before being debated in the States, particularly as Articles 2(1) and 2(2) of the draft Law provided an ability for the Minister to give effect to certain EU provisions by Order.
