

The Island Development Committee, having considered your [agent's] application hereby GRANTS PERMISSION in respect of the following change of use:-

RETROSPECTIVE: Change of use to reservoir and tree-scaped land open to the public proposed to be carried out at :-

Retreat Farm - land to north of main glasshouse complex, La Rue de la Frontiere, St. Lawrence

in accordance with the plan(s) accompanying the said application, subject to compliance with the following conditions.

- 1. That the development shall commence within one year of the date of this permit, which shall otherwise cease to be valid.
- Permission is granted only for the change of use of the land and/or building and not for any associated building works, which are to be subject of a separate application.
- 3. That no new access either pedestrian or vehicular shall be formed to the site.
- 4. That there shall be no further extension of commercial activity into this part of the site.
- 5. That there shall be no extension to the area open to the public beyond that which exists at present, and none beyond the existing fence in the north eastern corner of the site.
