### Retention Schedule

[Updated January 2016]

*Under the Public Records (Jersey) Law 2002 the Archivist appointed by Jersey Heritage is required to work with public authorities to produce retention schedules. The schedules list the public records produced by authorities, the length of time these records need to be retained for and the eventual disposal of the information – either to the Jersey Archive for permanent preservation or to be confidentially destroyed.*


*This schedule applies to all records, whether paper or electronic that are produced by Electrical Services.*


This schedule will be reviewed after 5 years. **Date of next review: January 2021**
