Background

The Clinical and Professional Advisory Forum provides recommendations to the JCM Programme Board, the Jersey Health and Care Partnership Board and any other Board at the discretion of the Chair or Vice Chair.

The Jersey Care Model (JCM)

The JCM is a multi-year, multi-agency programme of work across the health and care sector in Jersey. It aims to shift the delivery of health and care into a preventative focused model, built around the needs of Islanders. It will transform services from a facilities and institutional-focused delivery system into a flexible community-based system which is more suitable and sustainable for the Island.

Job purpose

The Clinical and Professional Advisory Forum will be a source of independent and expert advice for development of new system-wide care.

The Forum is responsible for the formulation and provision of professional guidance to the JCM Programme Board, the Jersey Health and Care Partnership Board and the User Experience Panel in order to assist them to make the best decisions about care pathways.

The Forum will be responsible for:

- Ensuring Jersey health and care strategy and policy is guided by clinical and professional expertise and ensures the highest levels of quality and safety
- Engaging the Health and Care Partnership Board and the User Experience Panel on health and care improvement
- Providing context from a professional point of view on all health and care matters
- Agreeing a standard methodology for development of evidence-based the pathways
- Agreeing which care pathways to develop
- Establishing sub-groups / working parties for specific care pathway development

The Forum will be made up of a range of clinicians and professionals from the health and care sector, representing their profession through the provision of their professional knowledge, not representing

They will be a non-statutory advisory body with no executive authority or legal obligations.

Job specific outcomes

Primary role of the Member

- To provide advice reflective of your profession in driving improvements to care pathways

- To provide pro-active coordination, input and support relative to your area of expertise for the development of care pathways
- To provide clinical and professional judgement on quality and safety
- To understand the local context relative to your profession to ensure that proposals work successfully to best meet the needs of the local population
- The promoting and sharing of innovation and good ideas to support the implementation of best practice

Specific to the role

- A commitment to attend monthly Forum meetings
- To lead working groups for pathway design
- Acknowledge that your responsibility will be to represent your area of professional expertise and not the views of your personal business or practice
- You must possess an appropriate qualification relevant to your profession. Professional registration is also required
- You will need to be able to explain how you are able to professionally represent your whole sector
- Posts may be remunerated as appropriate
- Posts will be fixed term in duration. If you are unable to fulfil the obligations of the role as defined within the Terms of Reference you may be requested to step down from the position before the end of the fixed term.
