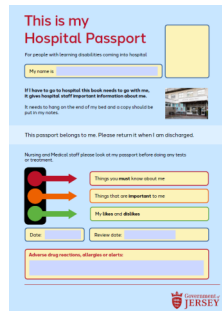
Libby Paisley is the Hospital learning disability nurse



Libby can help you when you come to hospital.

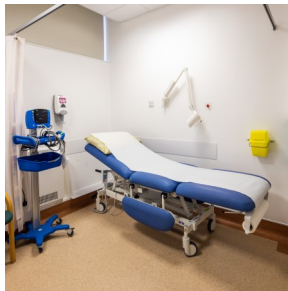


Libby can work with your family, carers and other people at the hospital to support you.



Libby can give you a hospital passport.

This tells us important things about you.



Libby can come with you to your appointments.



Libby can ask that you have more time to speak to people.



Libby can help you get ready to come into hospital and make sure you have everything you need when you leave hospital.

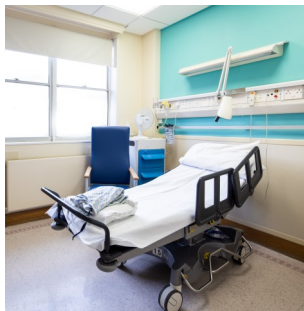


Libby sometimes uses pictures to show you things at the hospital.

This is to help you understand what will happen.



When you get a letter asking you to come to hospital– you can call Libby on her mobile phone and tell her the date and time of your appointment.



If you are staying in hospital the nurses looking after you can ask Libby to come and see you on the ward.
