	The Chair ensured that the forum members were satisfied with October's meeting notes before introducing the speakers.
3	Dementia Jersey Presentation
	The Co-Chair was joined by a representative from Health and Community Services to discuss the Dementia Strategy. Dementia is the fastest growing disease for people over the age of 65 and is the most expensive illness to treat. The representatives shared the five main points of the strategy which include: • Raise awareness to reduce risk • Diagnosing and providing quality of service • Supporting people with dementia and their families • Developing, valuing and supporting staff • Supporting Jersey to become dementia friendly and inclusive
	The Dementia Strategy is aiming to launch in February 2024.
	The representatives also advised social isolation can increase your risk of developing dementia. Other preventative measures such as regular sight and hearing tests and maintaining a healthy lifestyle were also discussed. If you have any concerns, please see your GP.

	A representative from the Disability and Inclusion team joined the forum. They explained the five main points of the Disability and Inclusion strategy which include:
	 Support to communicate and access information Greater access to the Island Good health and wellbeing Access to education, employment and enriching activities Equal rights and experience equality
	Members of the group brought up issues including various hotels and businesses being resistant to making alterations to provide more accessible services and signage at the hospital not being accessible for sight impaired individuals. The lack of cash points and branch closures were also discussed. To Action: Disability and Inclusion representative to contact banks regarding lack of cash points.
	The representative explained the Disability and Inclusion team are available to highlight accessibility issues to businesses on your behalf.
