Animal Welfare (Jersey) Law 2004 (“The Law”)

Application for an Animal Welfare Licence

A person shall not apply for a licence if that person is disqualified under Article 30 of the Law or any other enactment from keeping an animal or from holding any licence mentioned in that Article.

If you believe your business requires a Licence to operate, please complete this application form and return it to this office. The appropriate fee will be requested when an appointment for inspection is arranged. If you have more than one business which requires a Licence it may be possible for us to offer a reduced fee.

The granting of a Licence will be subject to compliance with the Code of Recommendation for the Welfare of the species and/or business to which the Licence applies. Codes are available on the States of Jersey website www.gov.je/PetIndustries or from our office.

Following inspection, if your business is considered non-compliant and you wish to become compliant, we will be pleased to discuss plans and a timescale to make necessary changes, during which time you may continue to operate.

If you are operating a business and/or a sanctuary and do not comply with the Law, you may be liable to prosecution.

Please allow 10 working days for the application process.
