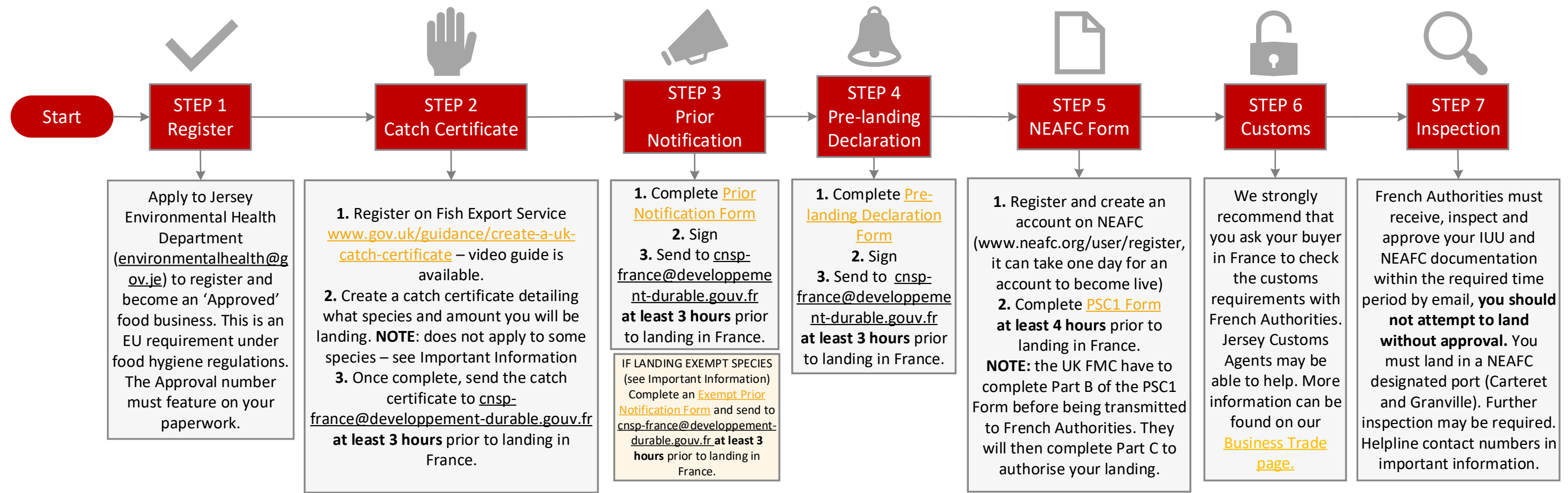

STEP BY STEP



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Ensure all landing information (species, presentation and total weight) entered on each form match identically, failure to do so will result in refusal or permission to land.
- Some fish and shellfish are excluded from the definition of 'fishery products' and do not need a UK catch certificate for export e.g. Scallops. Check [here](#).
- If you are landing only one species e.g. Scallops, you will need to complete an [Exempt Prior Notification Form](#) (instead of a Prior Notification Form). If you are landing a mixture of Scallops and other species, you will need to complete steps 1 to 7 above.
- Please send copies of all landing documentation (IUU and NEAFC) to Marine Resources (fisheries@gov.je).
- Please contact Environmental Health (environmentalhealth@gov.je) or Animal Health (pets@gov.je) if you are exporting Live Aquatic Animals (Aquaculture and Ornamental). These require health certification under EU SPS regulations.
