## THE IMMIGRATION (LANDING AND EMBARKATION CARD) DIRECTIONS 2017

**THE MINISTER FOR HOME AFFAIRS**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon her by paragraph 5 of Schedule 2 of the Immigration Act 1971 as extended to Jersey by the Immigration (Jersey) Order 1993, as amended by the Immigration (Jersey) (Amendment) Order 2017 ("the 1971 Act"), hereby gives the following directions.

- 1. Except as provided by paragraphs 3 and 4, a person aged 16 years or over who disembarks or embarks in the Bailiwick of Jersey shall produce to an immigration officer, if required, a landing card or embarkation card, as the case may be, duly completed.
- 2. The card shall be in such form as the Minister for Home Affairs may determine. It shall be supplied by the owners or agents of the ship or aircraft concerned.
- 3. A person who either has a right of abode under section 2 of the 1971 Act or who is an EEA national shall not be required to complete a card.
- 4. These directions shall not apply to a person disembarking from or embarking on a ship or aircraft coming from or going to a place in the common travel area.
- 5. These directions come into force on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2017
- 6. The Immigration (Landing and Embarkation Cards) Directions 2005 are revoked and replaced by these directions.
